Construction on U.S. 85 Dickinson District

- Reconstruction of US 85 from RP 51 to 57 north of Amidon
 - Construction cost is \$9,500,000
- Chip seal from Bowman to Belfield (with the exception of the 6-mile project above)
 - Construction cost was \$2,200,000



Planned on U.S. 85 in 2020 Dickinson District

- Lighting, extend the trail, and signing
 - Estimated cost: \$550,000


- Turn lanes, pedestrian crossing
 - Estimated cost: \$2,000,000



Construction on U.S. 85 Williston District

- From Canadian Border to ND5, 6.4 miles HBP overlay
 - Estimated cost: approx. \$2 million

- From Grassy Butte North 7.5 miles,
 Micro-surfacing approx.
 - Estimated cost: \$300,000



Construction on U.S. 85 Williston District (con't)

- 4-lane Safety Corridor between
 Watford City and Alexander, Signing,
 Pavement Marking, and Dynamic
 Message Boards, 14.8 miles
 - Estimated cost: approx. \$1 million



Construction on U.S. 85 Williston District (con't)

- 4-lane Long X Bridge replacement and wildlife structure, approach roadwork,
 2 miles
 - > Estimated cost: approx. \$34 million




Long X Bridge

Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) and Record of Decision (ROD)
